

EOT press-statement, 28 April 2014

The 2014 EOT season is about to start at the famous European Surf Break at Hossegor. The Surf Lifesaving Club from Hossegor hosts the Festival International Oceanman d'Hossegor on the first weekend of May (3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>).

Round 2 of the EOT will be in Croyde, Great Britain where we will return to the Legacy Elite series, hosted by the famous GB Oceanman Nick Thorne on the 21<sup>st</sup> of June. Round 3 will be in Rerik Germany, at the Hawaiian Sports Festival on the 28<sup>th</sup> of June. For round 4 we will return to Belgium for the Oxbow Oceanman, this time on a different location in Westende. Therefore we purposely choose to be this early!
